FACT SHEET

Abraded or brushed metal is achieved most often with fine grit sandpaper. The brushing gives the metal a distinctive look as it retains some but not all of its metallic luster and is given a pattern of very fine lines and swirls. In the hands of a master metalsmith all metals- whether it's as precious as platinum or a rusted piece of steel each take on a wonderful look and feel when they are being polished.
