

Fanfare is a term symbolically used for occasions for which there is much publicity. In a more literal sense, it is a short piece of music played by trumpets and other brass instruments usually for ceremonial purposes. We feel that this uniquely designed grass-like texture is certainly worthy of its namesake. The fan-shaped motifs have both an exotic and sophisticated appeal.
