

In Morocco, the landscape is a succession of vivid contrasts- burning sand and snow-covered mountaintops and breathtaking canyons that open into lush green country sides. Dotted this landscape are countless numbers of historic mud fortresses known as Kasbahs. Historically the Kasbah served as the seat of the local rules and was constructed for defense, exploiting the terrain to make it easier to defend whenever possible. Our pattern is a translation of the striated limestone gorges where many of these fortresses are located, combined with a large dose of the exotic, mystique and history of the locale.
